Arizona Code of Judicial Administration § 7-205(D)(6)(e)(4), Defensive Driving, authorizes the presiding judge to set conditions for defensive driving school continuances.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. All Arizona Supreme Court Defensive Driving Board certified schools are authorized and required to grant a one-time 45 day continuance from the original court arraignment date for all eligible civil traffic offenses to attend DDS that meet the following criteria:
 - a. The request is made prior to seven (7) calendar days of the original court arraignment date; and
 - b. The school shall inform the individual requesting the continuance that they must complete the defensive driving class at least seven (7) calendar days prior to the new court arraignment date.
2. The school must refer the individual to the Court if the request for continuance is made less than seven (7) calendar days prior to the original court arraignment date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. The Court shall allow a one-time 45 day continuance from the original court arraignment date for all eligible civil traffic offenses to attend DDS. The request must be made on or before the original court arraignment date.
2. If the date of the 45 day continuance falls on a Court holiday or a weekend day, the continuance will be made to the court's next business day.
3. The defendant is restricted to one 45 day continuance from the original court arraignment date to attend defensive driving class; any further requests must be referred to a Judicial Officer for determination.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this court order replaces Court Order # 09-01 issued on February 6, 2009 and is effective May 20, 2015.
