Scottsdale City Court participates in the Fines, Fees and Restitution Enforcement (FARE) program, implemented by the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2003-126 and 2009-01, which includes the application of Arizona Revised Statutes §§ 28-1631 through 1636 commonly known as the Traffic Ticket Enforcement Assistance Program (TTEAP); and,

**WHEREAS**, Arizona Revised Statute § 28-1635 provides for court waiver of vehicle registration holds imposed by TTEAP. The AOC has indicated that the courts may delegate review of TTEAP waiver requests to financial enforcement personnel to facilitate the consistent application of the statutory waiver requirements as long as those requesting a waiver are afforded the right to judicial review of TTEAP waiver denial and are provided written notice of such right; and,

**WHEREAS**, there is good cause appearing to delegate the initial review of TTEAP waiver applications to court clerks; therefore,

**IT IS ORDERED** delegating the review of all TTEAP waiver applications filed pursuant to § 28-1635 to court clerks.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** the court clerks in review of the TTEAP waiver application shall strictly and uniformly apply the standards provided in § 28-1635 and shall provide written notice to each TTEAP waiver applicant that in the event their application is denied, the application may then be reviewed by a judicial officer of the court.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Order shall replace Court Order No. 09-02 issued on September 10, 2009.
