The Court in review of the Arizona Supreme Court’s Task Force on *Fair Justice for All Report* is in support of the committee’s report and committed to adopting some of the recommendations.

WHEREAS Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2016-16 ordered that the Task Force of Fair Justice for All is established including the filing of a report of recommendations, referred to as “Report and Recommendations of the Task Force on Fair Justice for All: Court-Ordered Fines, Penalties, Fees, and Pretrial Release Policies”.

IT IS ORDERED in absence of a specific judicial order; upon a failure to appear by the defendant or his/her legal representative for a Civil Traffic Arraignment; AFTER A PERIOD OF FOURTEEN CALENDAR DAYS FROM THE DATE OF FAILURE TO APPEAR, the allegations of the complaint shall be deemed admitted, and a default judgment entered for the State, impose a civil sanction, and report such judgment to the Department of Transportation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED in absence of a specific judicial order; upon a failure to appear by the defendant or his/her legal representative for a Criminal Arraignment or Pre-trial Conference; AFTER A PERIOD OF FOURTEEN CALENDAR DAYS FROM THE DATE OF FAILURE TO APPEAR a warrant will be issued per Judicial Order.
