Arizona Code of Judicial Administration (ACJA) § 5-205: Collections prescribes the requirements of a court's collection practices.

WHEREAS Arizona Supreme Court Order No. 2018-30 amended ACJA § 5-205 to include guidelines for Compliance Assistance Programs, effective July 1, 2018.

WHEREAS Scottsdale City Court established a Compliance Assistance Program prior to Arizona Supreme Court AO 2018-30, and applies to cases that may not yet be in collections.

IT IS ORDERED continuing Scottsdale City Court Compliance Assistance Program for the following cases:

- a. Civil charges that are in default status that are not in collections status, and
- b. Post-adjudicated criminal charges without an outstanding warrant that are not in collections status.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that eligibility is based upon clerical review of the defendant's financial ability to pay, and once payment is received, the clerk will (in the following order of applicable events):

- a. Receipt the payment,
- b. Update the case disposition for the purpose of notifying Arizona Department of Transportation – Motor Vehicle Division, and
- c. Establish a payment agreement in accordance to the Court's Payment Agreement Policy.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order replaces Court Order 2018-03.
