The Court in review of the Arizona Judiciary’s strategic agenda, *Advancing Justice Together: Courts and Communities*, includes the goals of “Promoting Access to Justice” by exploring the use of technology-based access to justice solutions and “Improving Court Processes to Better Serve the Public” by improving timeliness and efficiency of processing court cases.

WHEREAS, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2019-04 establishes the Online Dispute Resolution (ODR) Pilot Project in the Scottsdale City Court and directs the Scottsdale City Court to establish eligibility criteria.

WHEREAS, Scottsdale City Court has been continuing working with the Arizona Administrative Office of the Courts to develop new ways of promoting Access to Justice using technology and explored the extension of ODR to parking offenses.

WHEREAS, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2019-73 authorizes Scottsdale City Court ODR Pilot Project to include parking ticket cases where defendants seek to resolve by way of a documentary hearing. Further directs the Court to establish eligibility criteria and develop written program policies, procedures, and guidelines.

IT IS ORDERED establishing eligibility criteria for parking cases to participate in the Online Dispute Resolution program as follows:

- a. Civil Parking Offense that the Defendant has requested a Hearing in accordance to Rule 10.2, AZ Rules of Civil Traffic and Civil Boating Violations, and
- b. State and Defendant agreement to participate in the using ODR.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if there is a specific judicial order that is different from the provisions of this Order, the specific judicial order shall supersede this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED directing the Administration of this Court to develop Program Policies, Procedures, and Guidelines.
