BRUSHES: Assortment of watercolor brushes/sizes. Mop head, chizel, liner, rounds and dagger. Sable is most popular type. Synthetic works also and are for watercolor/acrylic. These are great and a great refence of shapes. Buy as a kit or buy as singles.

HB pencil, Regular Eraser, Kneaded Eraser

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Small Container of Table Salt

Spritzer bottle, 2 water containers

Paper towels, Old hand Towel
